Day 1 - Arrive Cape Town

Welcome to South Africa!

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, proceed through immigration formalities. Then collect your baggage and meet your representative holding a sign with your name. Transfer to your hotel for check-in and overnight.

South Africa, positioned at the southern tip of the African continent, is acknowledged as "a world in one country." It offers a wealth of pristine wilderness, which is complemented by the country's warm hospitality.

■ Southern Sun The Cullinan Cape Town Set in Cape Town's Central Business District, this upscale hotel is 1 mile from the ferry to Robben Island and 1.5 miles from Two Oceans Aquarium.

Warm, stately rooms come with flat-screen TVs, free Wi-Fi, minifridges, and tea and coffee-making facilities. Suites add butler service.

A buffet restaurant specializing in Cape Malay fusion cuisine offers breakfast and dinner. There's also a casual bar that serves drinks and light snacks al fresco. Other amenities include a spa, an outdoor pool, and a fitness center, as well as 7 conference rooms.

This afternoon, enjoy the Signature - Wine Chocolates and Diamond experience.

- Full Day Cape Town Tour with Table Mountain Your tour offers the flexibility of seeing the highlights of Cape Town at your own leisurely pace. Enjoy breath-taking views from the cable car with fast track entry and summit to one of the seven natural wonders of the world: Table Mountain. Be moved by Cape Town's colourful past when you visit historic landmarks such as the Malay Quarter.

Cape Castle or Castle of Good Hope: Built by the Dutch after their arrival in 1666, the Castle was erected as a 5 pointed star on the foreshore of Cape Town. It is surrounded today by a variety of other monuments and places of historical interest. The Castle of Good Hope is the oldest surviving building in South Africa. Built between 1666 and 1679, this pentagonal fortification replaced a small clay and timber fort built by Commander Jan van Riebeeck in 1652 upon establishing a maritime replenishment station art the Cape of Good Hope for the Dutch East India Company, better known as the VOC (Verenigde Oos-Indische Compagnie). The Cape of Good Hope houses the regional headquarters of the South African Army in the Western Cape, the famous William Fehr Collection of historic artworks, the Castle Military Museum and ceremonial facilities for traditional Cape Regiments.

Table Mountain (weather permitting): Since the first person laid eyes on Table Mountain, it has exerted its powerful and charismatic pull, enchanting and drawing any and all who fall under its spell. The best views of Cape Town are seen from the top of Table Mountain. The Cableway summit is under 10 minutes and the cable car's rotating floor ensures that all passengers have an aerial view of the city. Table Mountain is a sandstone plateau rising up above the Cape Flats. The top is approximately 3km wide, and at its highest point, Maclear's Beacon, rises to 1085m. Over the centuries it has become one of South Africa's most famous landmarks. The steep cliffs and rocky outcrops of the mountain play home to a number of plants and animals. The mountain is home to approximately 1470 species of plants; more than the entire British Isles! Complimenting this vast array of flora is a stunning range of fauna, some, like the Table Mountain Ghost Frog, being found in no other place in the world.

- Full-Day Cape Peninsula Tour Cape Town is set on a spectacular mountainous peninsula jutting into the southern oceans. This full-day tour is an ideal way to see the highlights and appreciate the surrounding natural beauty. You'll travel along the Atlantic seaboard with its gorgeous white beaches and rugged mountains to Hout Bay. If open, you'll continue on Chapman's Peak Drive, renowned as one of the most stunning roadways in the world. You'll visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve, the tip of the Cape Peninsula that has captivated travelers for centuries with its dramatic scenery and fascinating history. The return journey to Cape Town takes you along False Bay coast with the option of visiting the colony of rare African Penguins at Boulders Beach. You'll pass through the naval village of Simon's Town, Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay, and Muizenberg.

Chapman's Peak :Cape Town's Chapman's Peak Drive is all about the scenery. Overlooking Noordhoek and Hout Bay, this rocky coastal roadway offers numerous points at which motorists can safely pull over and savor a panoramic view across the deep-blue waters of the Atlantic Ocean and the shapely shoreline that meets it. From stunning vantage points, some of which are up to 593m above sea level, it is not uncommon to see whales and dolphins frolicking in the ocean below, and baboon troops curiously observing passing tourists. This is a perfect place from which to take stunning photographs of the Cape.

Boulders Beach: Thereafter travel through the historic naval base of Simon's Town where guests will be able to visit a colony of African Penguins in their natural environment at Boulders Beach. Boulders Beach has a lot going for it: the ancient granite boulders protect it from the wind and large waves, making it an ideal swimming spot for kids. Because it falls under the Table Mountain National Park Marine Protected Area, the beach is always clean and safe, and it is rarely crowded.

Upon arrival at Victoria Falls Airport, proceed through immigration formalities. Then collect your baggage and look for a signboard with your name. Transfer to Insika Lodge for check-in and overnight. This evening, enjoy the sunset cruise onboard the flagship Zambezi Explorer's Signature Deck'.

Victoria Falls - no doubt one of the major highlights - can be experienced at ground level or through "The Flight of Angels", which aptly refers to the Helicopter Flights over and around Victoria Falls. It originated from the phrase coined by David Livingstone when he first documented discovering the falls: "Scenes so lovely must have been gazed upon by Angels in Their Flight." It is a great name - it describes this activity perfectly as it is surely one of the finest experiences you can have. At ground level, you can feel the enormous power of Victoria Falls as tremendous volumes of water pound into the chasm below, but it is only when you take to the air that you can take in the whole panorama and enormity of this mighty spectacle.

- Sunset Cruise- Signature Deck A visit to Victoria Falls isn't complete without a mesmerizing Sunset Cruise, and the 'Signature Deck' of the flagship Zambezi Explorer is the best choice for this. Uniquely designed, the upper 'Signature Deck' is utter sophistication, and guests are encouraged to relax into the deep-set couches that reflect the earthy tones and river blues found in the surroundings. Enjoy uninterrupted views from the 6m elevation, delicious canapés, and the service of a dedicated mixologist.
- Insika Lodge Insika (IN-SEE-KA) is an isi-Ndebele word meaning "Pillar of Strength". It speaks of the wonder of the Victoria Falls which shoots up a pillar of cloud that can be seen from as far as 32 miles at certain times of the year.

The main lodge area provides a variety of living spaces from which to appreciate the astounding natural beauty of the area. Expansive decks deepen connections with the landscape and our firepit and bar deli overlooks the woodland to provide the perfect setting for delicious meals and fireside storytelling.

Their exquisitely decorated rooms offer a rare African Elegance and the utmost comfort for weary travelers and energetic adventurers alike.
